DAY ONE

Fly from Auckland to Kerikeri.

Stay at multiple award winning Paihia Beach Resort & Spa in the Bay of Islands. La Spa Naturale was voted one of the top ten overseas hotel spas in Australia & South Pacific in the *Condé Nast Traveller (UK) Spa Awards*.

DAY TWO

Play the best course in New Zealand with panoramic views of the Pacific Ocean.

Named amongst the top 100 golf courses in the world by Golf Magazine, Kauri Cliffs Golf Course is one of only two New Zealand courses to receive this international recognition.

DAY THREE

Depart Bay of Islands and drive to Auckland.

Stay two nights at Seafields, a luxury Whitford waterfront retreat nestled on the shores of the Hauraki Gulf offering magnificent views overlooking boats and islands of the Gulf.

DAY FOUR

Formosa Golf Resort has been developed as an international PGA standard, 18-hole golf course and resort facility.

It is listed as one of “The Finest Golf Clubs of the World”, and was the venue for the 1998 New Zealand Open.

DAY FIVE

Drive to Rotorua, New Zealand’s Maori culture centre.

Stay two nights at Kawaha Point Lodge, situated on the edge of Lake Rotorua, and winner of Best Boutique Accommodation at the Tourism Industry Awards 2006.

DAY SIX

Play 18 holes in scenic countryside.

Recognised by prestigious *US Golf Digest Magazine* to be in the top 20 courses in the world outside of the USA, the Wairakei International Golf Course lies on 450 acres of rolling countryside.

DAY SEVEN

Drive to the Hawke’s Bay.

Stay two nights at Greenhill the Lodge, Hastings. Built in 1897, this regal home stands on 30 acres of gardens with panoramic views of the region. Play alongside the locals with complimentary green fees to the Hastings Golf Club, known as ‘Bridge Pa’.

DAY EIGHT
