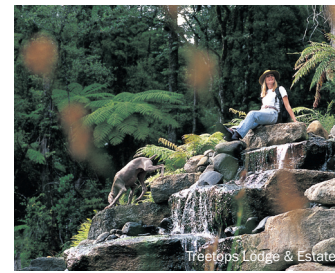


ADVENTURE SAMPLE ITINERARY



From jet-skis to mountain bikes, quad bikes to horses or hiking, these Navigate Oceania lodges and resorts offer two, three and four-night adventure itineraries to get the heart rate up and experience the feel-good rush in New Zealand and the Pacific's fabled outdoor life, beaches and wilderness. Of course there is New Zealand's famed bungy jumps, but also discover jet-boating on rushing rivers, join a mustering gang or trout fish in quiet streams and lakes. Helicopter expeditions zoom you to other adventures in untouched natural wilderness seen only in 'Lord of the Rings'. You could only be in clean, green New Zealand. . . But fancy a tropical island paradise as a stopover? In Fiji, there's a heart-stopping flying-fox adventure, momentous white water rafting, surf breaks, shark diving and so much more.

ROYAL DAVUI ISLAND | FIJI

On your first day the ultimate thrill of Royal Davui Island's Shark Dive Experience is on your tropical island doorstep. Swim in a swirling throng of fish such as Jacks, Snapper and Grouper. And then, if you dare, with Bull, Tiger, Lemon and Silvertip sharks. Otherwise, snorkel and scuba dive to explore Beqa Lagoon private coral reef. Next day experience white-water rafting in the remote tropical highlands of Viti Levu is an enthralling river adventure along the Navua River, a hidden pathway through pristine tropical wilderness. Prefer to soar like a bird across canyons and seeing inaccessible rain forest sights? The Flying Fox Adventure awaits. Or like to surf remote breaks – *DBB 4 nights*

CAVALLI ISLAND RETREAT & SPA | CAVALLI ISLANDS

A private island, located in a wildlife sanctuary in New Zealand's fabled Bay of Islands is the perfect base to enjoy every kind of water sport. On your first day explore the maritime wildlife sanctuary by jet-ski and take as much time as you like to snorkel the untouched reefs. On your second day, Rainbow Warrior, the Greenpeace ship famously sunk in Auckland's harbour, is

now here for spectacular diving experiences. After a day of high adrenaline, on this ultra-exclusive retreat there's a Vichy shower, an outside hydro spa bath, steam room and heated saltwater pool, gourmet cooked breakfasts, barbecue dinners and full use of these amazing spa facilities to set you up for more adventure.

WAIPOUA LODGE | NORTHLAND

Heaven for wilderness lovers. The lodge lies at the heart of hiking and biking trails in indigenous forest with no equivalent elsewhere in the world. On your first day hike to see Tane Mahuta, a gigantic kauri God of the Forest, a life enhancing experience. Mountain-bike the Old Coach Road through Waipoua Forest one of the 101 'must do' adventures before you die; you might even hear the rare kokako bird calling. Horse lovers will adore cantering up rivers and over wooded farmland in an afternoon expedition on your second day. Then head off to Bailey's Beach to collect a four-wheel quad bike to speed freely over golden beaches and sand dunes on your final day's adventure. *DBB | 3 nights*

TREETOPS LODGE & ESTATE | ROTORUA

Frankly, it's an adventure just to stay at Treetops and explore the wilderness floor and canopy of this great estate. In this world-famed trout-fishing centre, let your guide plan a memorable event at close-by rivers and lakes or as far away as untouched headwaters. Private guiding available from entry level from beginner to advanced is guaranteed unforgettable experiences. And on the doorstep, hiking and biking adventures for all ages and stages reveal natural springs, waterfalls, trout streams, lakes and direct contact with wildlife and birds. Vowed by many as the very best adventure activity in New Zealand, on your second day fly with the lodge's own helicopter to walk on the live volcano of White Island, boiling with seismic activity and then by heli to the summit of tragic Mt Tarawera. *DBB | 2 days*

TONGARIRO LODGE | TONGARIRO NATIONAL PARK

Set at the foot of World Heritage Tongariro National Park, outdoor adventure is this lodge's lifeblood - from the gentleness of world-famed trout fishing to white-water excitement on the Tongariro River's 60 raging rapids. On your first day, private access to remote wilderness means astonishing experiences for recreational anglers and serious fly fishermen; heli-fishing in the Kaimanawas, too. Your second day explores the Tongariro Alpine Track, one of the world's greatest one-day hikes, including active volcanoes, cold mountain springs, lava flows and magnificent lake views. Plenty of gentler walks and rides, too. On your final day, play with the tail of the mighty Huka Falls at 80km per hour by jetboat. *DBB | 3 days*

WHAREKAUHAU COUNTRY ESTATE | MARTINBOROUGH

Join a mustering gang to bring in sheep or cattle. After meeting your mount on your first day, enjoy a leisurely two-hour ride around the estate to get comfortable on your steed and take in the breathtaking views. Next day, saddle up your horse, check your pack, and ride down Ted's Track through the canyon of the Wharekauhau River to the coast. Boil up a billy-can and relax with a cuppa and a scone at Corner Creek and then find the animals. After the round-up move them on and then drive the animal's home along the rugged coast and up the final hill to Wharekauhau. *DBB | 3 nights*

EDENHOUSE - NELSON

This prestigious lodge, one of Tatler's '101 Best Hotels of the World' is only 30 minutes from the Abel Tasman National Park - one of New Zealand's most spectacular natural wonders. A full-day Sea & Air Adventure down the wild West Coast starts with an exploration of the park's golden beaches and lagoons. Then fly with unforgettable bird's-eye views of Abel Tasman National Park, including Golden Bay and Farewell Spit, the

world's longest natural sandbar and seeing untouched coastal forests. Land at Karamea to enjoy a drink with West Coasters before returning. *DBB | 2 nights*

RELEASE PRIVATE RETREAT | WANAKA

Three extraordinary adventures over three days are complemented with a private chef for two nights and a visiting masseur on the third. First a guided heli-fly-fishing day in a secret destination high in the Southern Alps. Then a heli-diving cruise over the Alps to the most remote untouched wilderness in New Zealand so you can gather your share of tasty crayfish and explore the pristine West Coast Waters. Your private chef prepares your crayfish banquet. Next day it's heli-biking, flying to the rugged, exhilarating terrain of the Pisa Range followed by personal massage in the retreat. Unforgettable. *DBB | 3 nights*

REMARKABLES LODGE | QUEENSTOWN

Set only minutes from the premier South Island playground of Queenstown and Lake Wakitipu. This is your base for the original bungy jump at the famed Nevis Highwire Bungy, 134m above the rugged Nevis River. Before leaving, experience the pioneering Shotover River-Jet experience. Then this special three-night adventure flies you by helicopter to the remote 65,000 acre Walter Peak High-Country Station: enjoy a night in the wilderness in a restored musterers' hut (gourmet meals provided) and next day thrill to a visually spectacular 3-4 hour hike out, returning to the lodge across the lake on SS Earnslaw. *DBB | 3 nights*
